INTRODUCTION TO LOG FRAME AND TERMIOLOGIES	
Definition of Log Frame	A Log frame is a management tool for effective planning, implementation, management, monitoring and evaluation of developmental projects. It provides clear, concise and systematic information about a project. The Framework helps in connecting the impact, outcomes and outputs presenting the tight relationship between them, leading to the achievement of the expected outcomes.
Importance of Log Frame	Aids in Monitoring and Evaluation Examine the progress of the project Co-relate activities carried out and results achieved
Impact	Positive and negative long-term effects produced by a development intervention, directly or indirectly, intended or unintended.
Outcome	Change in a policy or practice or both of development actors influenced by our grantee's' activities and outputs
Outputs	The immediate result of a grantee's activities – the processes, goods and services that is produced through activities partially or totally funded by us. These are results which should be within the control of the project management
Other reference documents	Kindly note that, there are other reference documents that complement the log frame (ie. M&E manual, framework and complement of indicators). It is also important to note that these tools are not stand alone document but should be used collectively
